

No cash freeze for adventurer

FUND-RAISING efforts for Nicola Le Feuvre's expedition to the Arctic are going well.

Mrs Le Feuvre and her team are busy organising various events including a 70s and 80s disco night, a car boot sale, a raffle and a Mediterranean evening at Oil & Vinegar.

Expeditions such as this require logistical air support and, along with the specialist equipment required, this makes it an expensive adventure. Just to take part Mrs Le Feuvre needs to raise £9,900.

She plans to pay a substantial part of this herself and is already nearly halfway to the total.

As soon as the expedition costs have been met, all the money raised will go to the Pink Ladies.

Gillian Tidd, from the breast cancer support group, was delighted with Mrs Le Feuvre's efforts.

'We are amazed at the lengths people like Nicola will go to raise funds and delighted to be selected. In particular our lymphedema programme will benefit in 2006,' she said.

The nine-day expedition, organised by Absolute Arctic, begins in April. The mother-of-two will pull a sledge 100 miles over frozen glaciers and battle temperatures as low as -30C. Mrs Le Feuvre is also looking for people to sponsor her per mile with all money raised this way going directly to the Pink Ladies.
